Charleston Women in International Trade Criteria for 2010 Scholarship Award

Two \$3,000.00 scholarships will be awarded.

1. Females and males are invited to apply.
2. Applicant must be well qualified, with a serious interest in pursuing a degree specific to international trade or related course of study.
3. Provide a two-page (minimum length), double-spaced essay explaining the importance of international trade and state your goals for working in the international business environment. Please list courses or work experience relevant to your interest in international trade. You must also explain why you believe you should be awarded this highly competitive scholarship. This essay is weighed as 55% of the application value, so focus on content, grammar, spelling, and neatness.
4. Applicant must be enrolled/enrolling in an accredited school, institution, college or university and must provide proof of acceptance or current enrollment.
5. Applicant must provide a recommendation letter from a teacher, professor, or work place supervisor supporting your interest in international trade.
6. Applicant must provide an **Official transcript from the Registrar's Office** of grades (to include high school if entering college), or work history if transcripts are not applicable.
7. Applicant must provide a listing of extra curricular activities, civic and community involvement and define accordingly.
8. Applicant need not be a full-time student.
9. Applicant must be a full-time resident of South Carolina and a U. S. citizen.
10. Financial need will be considered. Please provide any financial aid or tuition information if applicable.
